11. The transports of emigration

For the azoreans get to Canada, there were several processes needed. Ships used to transport the emigrants through sea, like the *Saturnia*, or the *Nea Hellas*. Later, when they started to go by plane from the island of Santa Maria, they would catch a ship to this island, or a plane, namely, through Lages in Terceira island, or Santana, in São Miguel.

Ships like the *Arnel* or *Carvalho Araújo* transported emigrants to the island of Santa Maria. Arrived to Canada, they would catch a train to the final destiny, but in some cases, they could have to catch another plane.

In Santa Maria they would catch planes of K.L.M., T.W.A., of Air France and also from Canadian Pacific and others to Canada.
